The Omaha Tribal Council, acting through its enumerated power as the government of the Omaha Indian Tribe, hereby establishes a village boundary for the Village of Macy, Nebraska described as follows:

The starting point for the town and Village of Macy is the center of Section Twenty-five, Township Twenty-five North, Range Nine East of the Sixth Principal Meridian, thence due north to the center of Section Thirteen, Township Twenty-five, Range Nine East of the Sixth Principal Meridian, thence due west to the center of Section Fifteen, Township Twenty-five North, Range Nine East of the Sixth Principal Meridian, thence due south to the center of Section Three, Township Twenty-four North, Range Nine East of the Sixth Principal Meridian, thence due east to the center of Section Five, Township Twenty-four North, Range Ten East of the Sixth Principal Meridian, thence due north to the center of Section Seventeen, Twenty-five North, Range Ten East of the Sixth Principal Meridian, thence due west to the center of Section Thirteen, Township Twenty-five North, Range Nine East of the Sixth Principal Meridian, consisting of Four Square Miles.

The Omaha Tribal Council hereby establishes a Board of Supervisors to consist of seven (7) members who reside within the city boundaries of Macy, to enact ordinances upon final approval of the Tribal Council that protects the Health and Welfare and Safety of the citizens of the city/village of Macy.

The Board of Supervisors will be appointed by the Tribal Council and will serve a period specified with position to which they are appointed; example: 1. Chairman 2 years; Vice-Chairman 2 years; Secretary 2 years; 4 members 1 year.
