## Resolution of the Omaha Tribe of Nebraska

Re: To approve and endorse the formulation of a "Tribal Emergency Response Commission" and to designate individuals to serve on this planning effort.

Resolution Number: 95-40

Whereas, the Omaha Tribe of Nebraska is a federally recognized Indian Tribe organized under the Indian Reorganized Act of June 18, 1934 (25 USC 476) as amended, and

Whereas; the Omaha Tribe did adopt Resolution Number 94-152 on May 19, 1994 seeking funding from the United States Environmental Protection Agency through it's Innovative Technical Assistance Program to aid the conduct activities to prepare for Chemical Emergencies, and

Whereas; the Omaha Tribe of Nebraska was successful in receiving funding in the amount of \$46,636 in federal funds for a total project designed to cost \$62,182, and

Whereas; one key component of the Innovative Technical Assistance Grant is the formation and continued operation of a Tribal Emergency Response Commission,

Now Therefore Be It Resolved That the Omaha Tribal Council hereby authorizes the creation of the Omaha Tribal Emergency Response Commission, and




